Save Chris P. Bacon





Oh no! There is a pig stuck under water and a big scary shark is keeping him hostage!

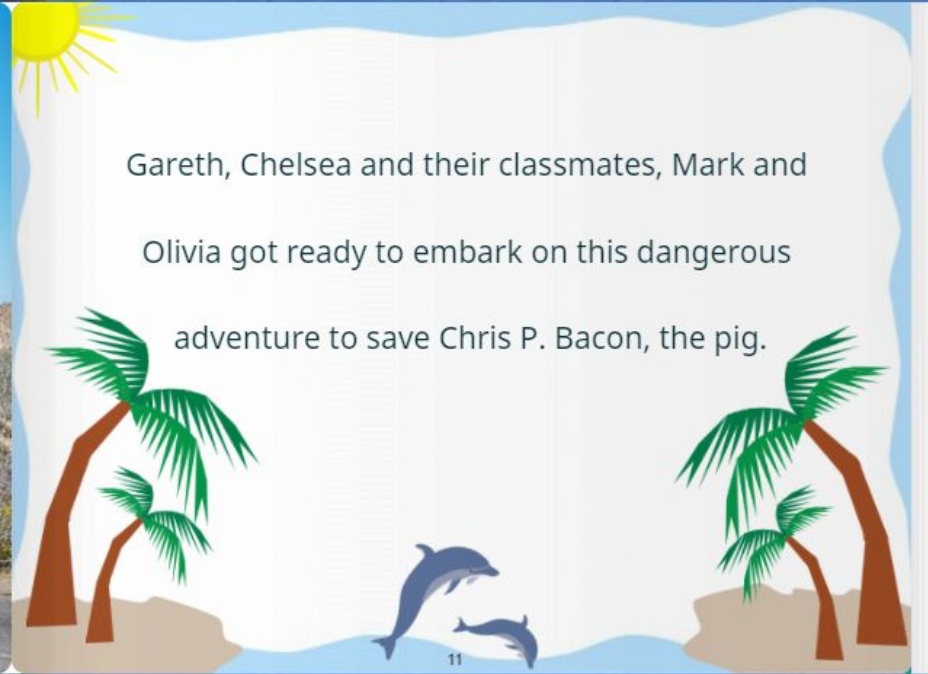


Kids, we should go save him at once! Quick, to your diving suits and on the bus!

Gareth, Chelsea and their classmates, Mark and Olivia got ready to embark on this dangerous adventure to save Chris P. Bacon, the pig.

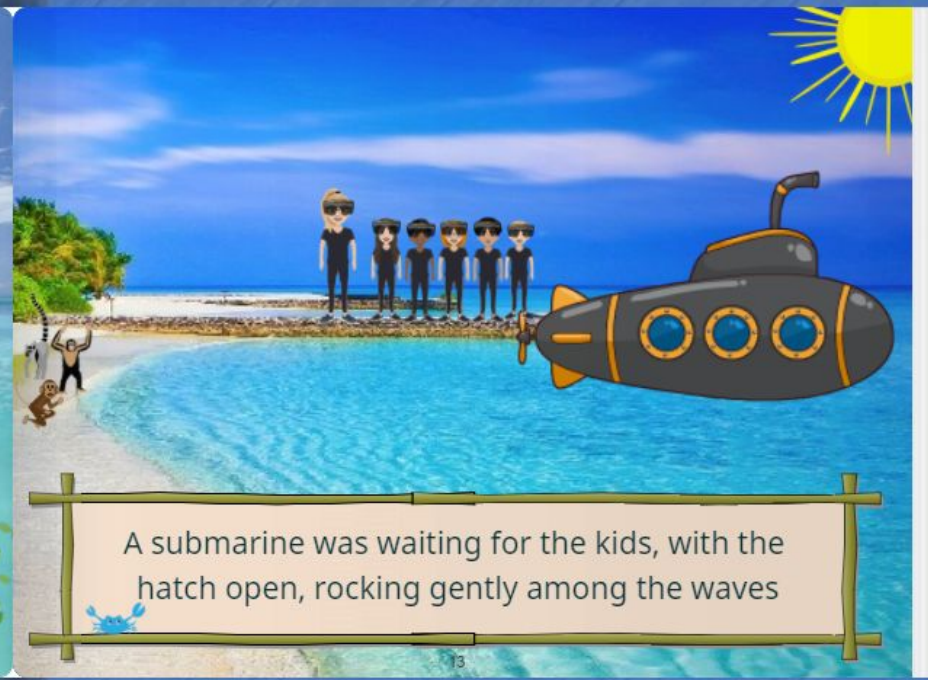

Woah, that octopus has many arms! Look at the starfish laying on the coral! And, the seahorse swimming among the seaweeds!

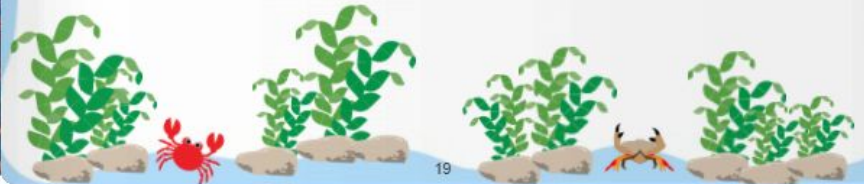


Finally, they arrive at the shark's lair

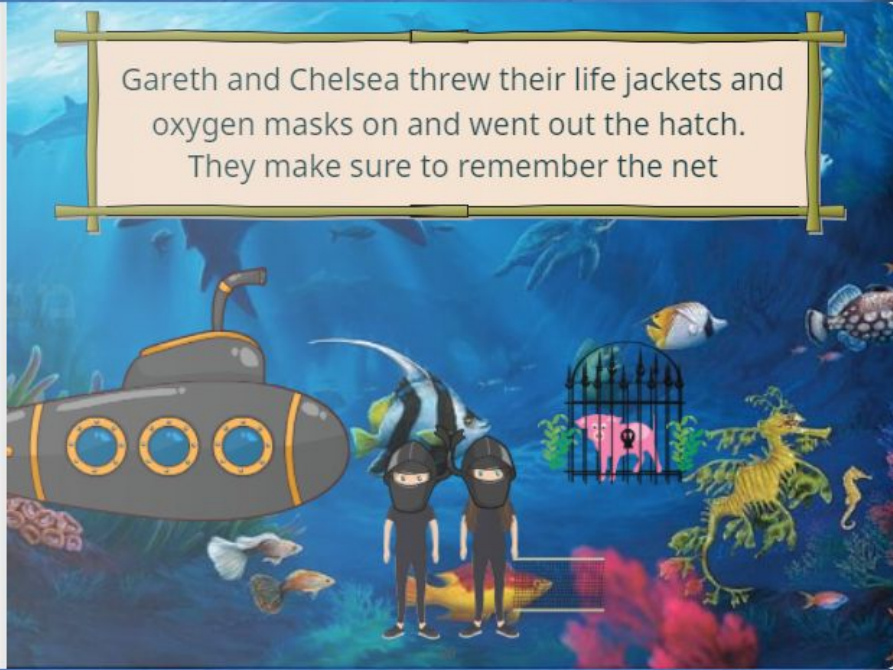




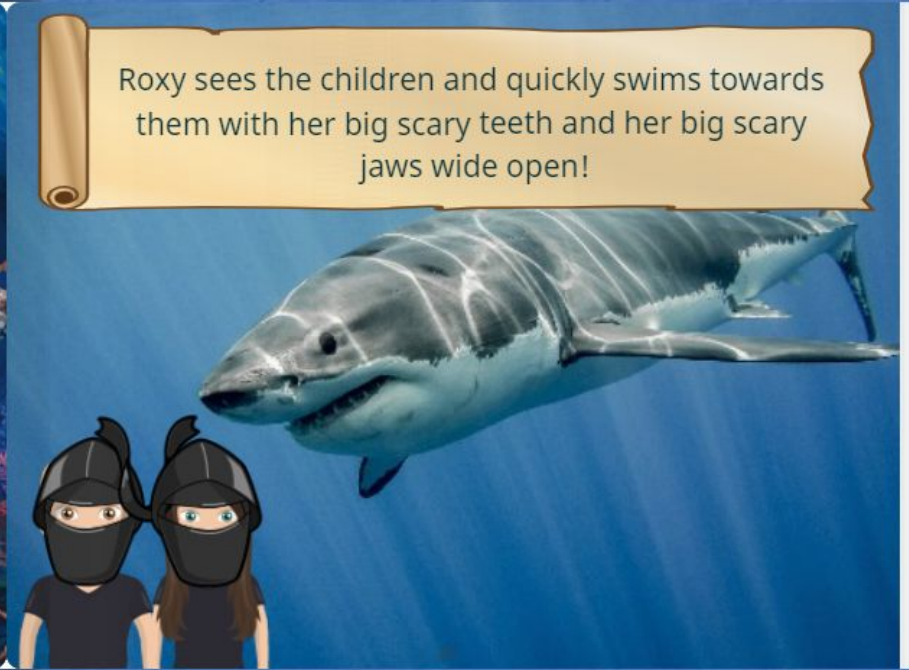
Chris P. Bacon was in a dark cage,

shaped eyes



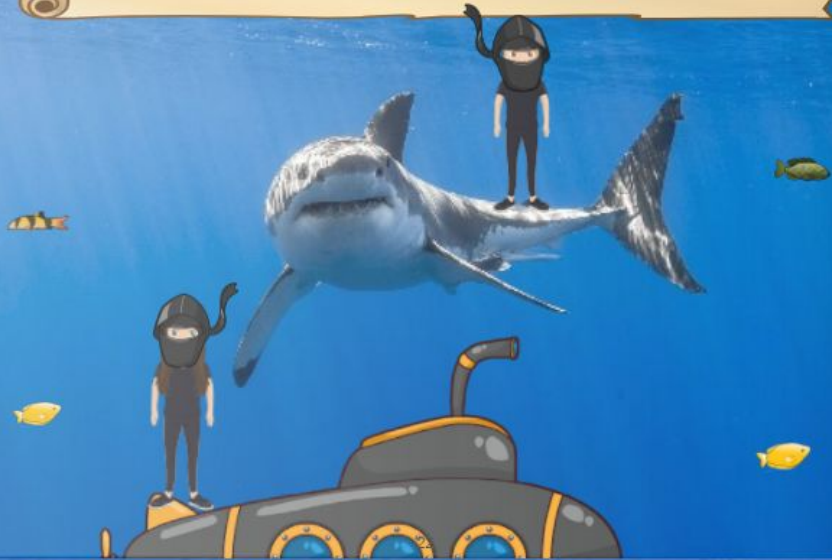
Gareth and Chelsea threw their life jackets and oxygen masks on and went out the hatch. They make sure to remember the net

Mark and Chelsea work together to trick Roxy



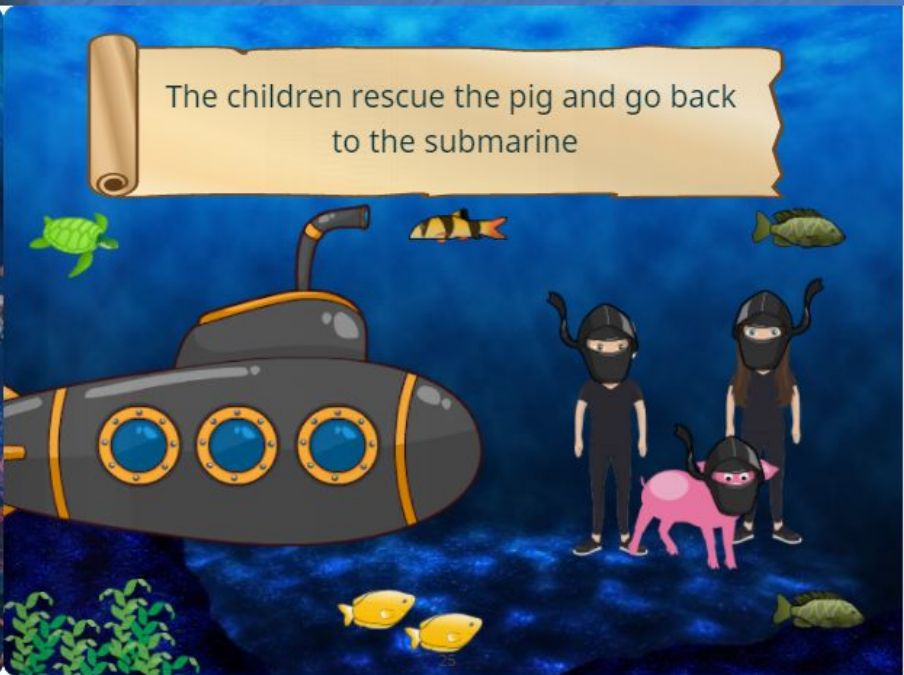
Chelsea swims towards Chris P. Bacon
and as she turns her back to Mark...



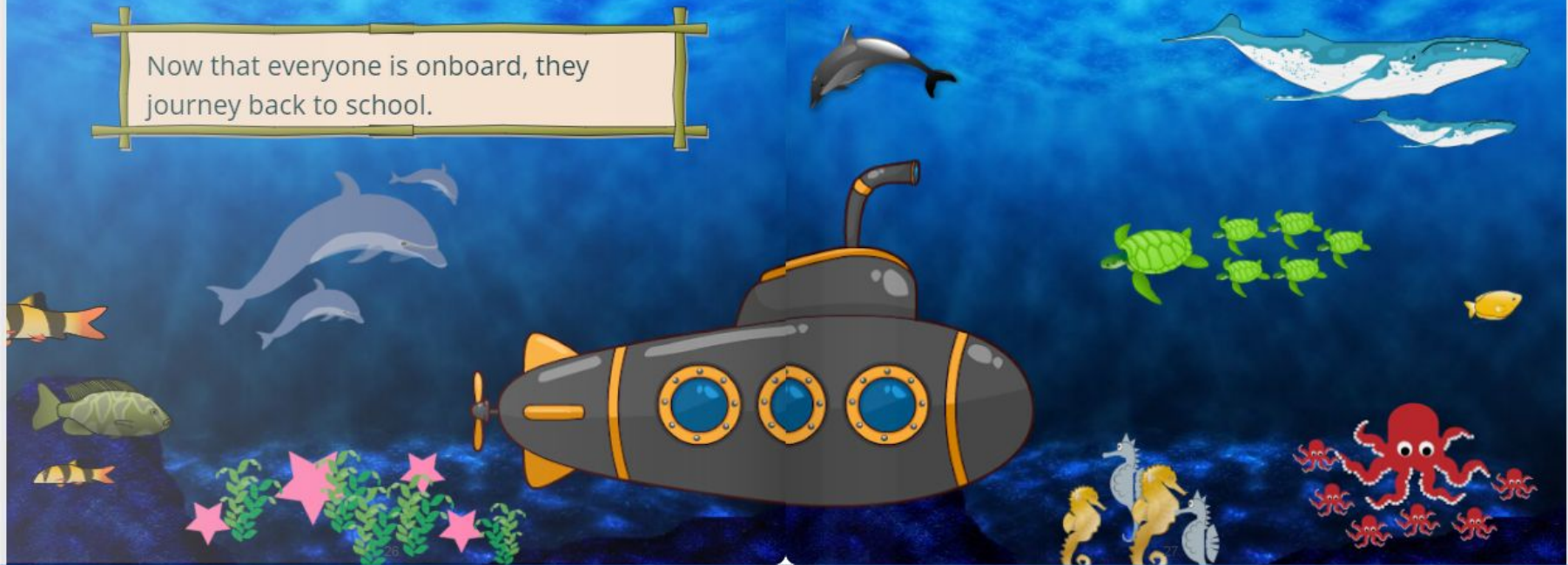


...Mark throws the net over

Now that everyone is onboard, they journey back to school.

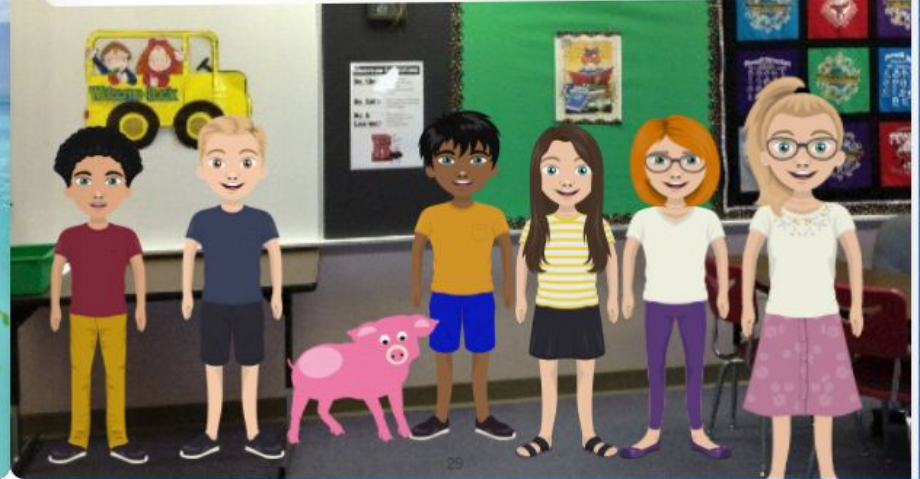


The students and teacher arrive back to the shore and park the submarine by the dock


